Brief Description of the Project

7 organizations/groups coming from France, North Macedonia, Bulgaria, Turkey, Italy, Spain and Germany will take place in the youth exchange. 6 participants (1 group leader + 5 young people) per organization are invited to the exchange.

Working Methods and Methodology of Youth Exchange: The methods and techniques used during youth exchange will be chosen with a goal to strengthen the participants' theoretical knowledge of digital citizenship and to provide them with an opportunity to gain practical experiences in the field. The methods and techniques will be based on non-formal education and support the active participation of young people in the process. How we mentioned before group leaders will prepare and deliver the programme of the youth exchange together with their participants. Direct involvement of the participants in the process of preparation and implementation of youth exchange we consider significantly important for raising their self-confidence and developing a feeling of ownership over the project. In this way the participants will be motivated to share lessons learned with their peers, to actively take part in visibility and dissemination activities. In line with set project objectives, we decided on following focus/aims of the sessions. DAY 1: to get to know each other, to break the barriers between participants, to get to know participants expectations, needs, to create an open and supportive learning environment, to increase participant's knowledge on non-formal education, YouthPass, to reflect on the importance of reflection in the learning process. DAY 2: to open debate on the concept of digital citizenship; to learn about the elements; to discuss the connection between digital citizenship and active youth participation. DAY 3: to get to know best practices from participating countries in the field of digital citizenship, to provide the participants and space to reflect on their digital citizenship competence (knowledge, attitude, skills), and to make an individual plan to increase their knowledge, skills, and attitude; DAY 4: to offer a variety of group activities with the aim to develop digital competencies of participants including activity supporting increasing critical thinking, media literacy skills, practical digital skills including creating content for social media and networks. DAY 5: to work on short videos with an aim to raise the interest of young people in digital citizenship; to shoot the materials, to edit them, and to share them through a project web page, social networks of the applicant, and participating organizations. DAY 6: to increase participants knowledge on Erasmus+ Programme, to provide them with an opportunity to learn about key the structure of the programme, its priorities, objectives, to provide participants with an opportunity to brainstorm ideas for future projects and work on their development in mix intercultural teams; DAY 7: to present newly developed project ideas and to create action plans for their implementation, to

gather lessons learned, and to provide the participants an opportunity to share feedback through final evaluation session. Moreover, during youth exchange, we will pay attention to support intercultural learning of the participants e.g. they will self-organized evening programme giving them an opportunity to explore the traditions, customs and habits of other countries.

Travel costs will be covered, based on the country of participants, up to foreseen limits. The exact amount written on the ticket will be accepted. **Please do not book tickets from travel agencies.** Please note that travels should be by economy class and public transport.

Each participant is responsible for buying their own tickets, in accordance with the guidelines. Refer to the travel budget for the maximum covered amount. Participants will receive reimbursements (in euro) by bank Transfer upon their return home, AFTER providing original tickets, invoices and boarding passes. Name of passenger, price, currency, and date of purchase should be clearly visible on all documents to be viable for reimbursement.

The coordination organization does not cover the additional bank fee of the international transaction. We strongly advise you to make copies of your tickets and invoices before your arrival. Also please note, that copies of tickets are not enough - we need original documents. Therefore, the best option for the return tickets is to buy them online, so you can print them multiple time.

- After buying your tickets you will have to load all of your travel documents to the google drive link which will be sent by the coordinator.

- If there are any doubts about invoices/ tickets, the coordinating organization has a right to ask for bank proof and confirmation of the transaction charged for the tickets.

Health Insurance
